A Workshop will be held in Dublin, Ireland on May 15th, 2009 on the international reporting standards for mineral resources and mineral reserves

Keynote papers will be presented highlighting the importance of a vibrant natural resource sector for European society and the role that resource reporting has in its sustainable development. The CRIRSCO family of reporting codes will be described, with emphasis on the PERC Code, and their relationship to the Russian system explained. The importance of high standards of resource reporting for financing resource development in today's difficult financial markets will be discussed, as will the relationship with the recently enacted EU Mine Waste Directive. Case studies will also be presented on the implementation of resource reporting codes within different sectors of the resource industry

The Workshop will be of benefit to all those working in or associated with the natural resources sector, especially to those in the exploration, evaluation, reporting and financing of new discoveries.
