Registration:

We request that everyone who plans to attend the meeting, **including** those submitting abstracts, register by 5pm on Friday, 30th January. Please also indicate whether you will be attending the conference meal as this will allow us to finalise catering numbers. Please register by emailing your name and institution to chewd@tcd.ie including "IGRM registration" in the subject heading.

Abstracts:

The deadline for receipt of abstracts is Friday 30th January at 5 pm (this has been extended by one week from the first circular). Contributions (talks and posters) to the meeting must be in the broad area of Earth Sciences, and must have an Irish connection (i.e. the research must be about a topic relevant to Ireland, or the research must have been carried out in an Irish institution). In your submission, please indicate whether you wish your contribution to be in the form of a **talk** or a **poster**. If you are a postgraduate, please also indicate which year of your research you are in. Poster contributions from undergraduates are most welcome.

Abstracts should be sent as an attachment in Word format to chewd@tcd.ie and should be completed in Times New Roman, 12 point, with the speaker underlined (see attached template). Please save your abstract with the surname of the first author and the institution name, e.g. graham_tcd.doc. Abstracts should be no more than 200 words in length.

Talks / Posters:

Talks will use PowerPoint unless otherwise requested. Speakers are allocated 15 minutes, with 12 minutes for the presentation and 3 minutes for questions. In keeping with previous years, there will be no parallel sessions. If more talks are offered than can be scheduled, those submitting abstracts for talks that cannot be accommodated will be offered the alternative of a poster presentation. Posters should be in portrait format (91cm maximum width and 160cm maximum height).

Conference meal:

A conference meal is being organised for the Saturday night (February 21st) of the conference. The meal will cost €20 and will take place in the Jameson Whiskey Museum in Smithfield. Please indicate when you are registering if you wish to attend so we can finalise numbers. The technical programme, details of guest speakers and venues will be issued in a final circular in early February.
