This Years IMQS Field Trip will be to the Corrib Gas Project at Belmullet, County Mayo. Members will be given a guided tour of many aspects of the onshore side of this project. Numbers are limited so it is advisable to book early to avoid disappointment as this promises to be an extremely interesting and insightful trip.



Message from the President

The Corrib Project is the largest infrastructure development being undertaken in Ireland at present. The safe and timely exploitation of this important natural resource is extremely important regionally and nationally. The pipeline pull-in to the landfall was completed in late

June; this represents a major milestone. The next major element of work pending is the onshore pipeline from the landfall to the Gas Terminal; this was subject to a 5 week Oral Hearing by Board Pleanala which concluded in June and a decision is expected around September. There are lessons to be learned from this Project; undoubtedly mistakes were made by the developer(s) in the early stages. I believe that these have been addressed at this point and hope for a successful completion to the works.

Situated in Béal an Mhuirthead (Belmullet) along the magnificent Atlantic coastline in North Mayo, the Broadhaven Bay Hotel and Country Club will be the venue for Dinner on Thursday night, with overnight accommodation and breakfast the following morning.



Field Trip

This is a fantastic opportunity to visit the Corrib Gas Project which is currently under construction at Belmullet, Co. Mayo. The project cost is €1.5 billion, it incorporates 9km of onshore pipeline (83km off-shore), a gas terminal located on a 15 hectare site which is 75% complete. During the construction phase the project generates around 1,000 jobs. On completion over 100 full time jobs will be generated. The project brings €5m in wages and services each week to the area. The field trip will include a presentation by Shell, a tour of the terminal, a visit to the peat storage area, compliments of Bord na Mona and depending on construction activities, a trip to the pipeline landfall site.
